

General Terms and Conditions for PAC Events

1. Ticket Purchases and Refunds

- All tickets are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled or rescheduled by the organisers.
- In the event of a cancellation, ticket holders will be notified via the contact details provided at the time of booking.
- Tickets are valid only for the specified event and cannot be resold for commercial gain.

2. Admission and Conduct

- The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission or require any person to leave the event if their behaviour is deemed disorderly, offensive, or a safety risk.
- Entry requirements (such as age limits or specific dress codes) will be detailed on the individual event listing and must be adhered to.
- Please arrive by the advertised start time; late entry is at the discretion of the event staff.

3. Catering and Allergies

- At events where food or drink is served, guests are responsible for notifying the organisers of any specific dietary requirements or life-threatening allergies by the requested deadline.
- While every effort is made to accommodate guests, we cannot guarantee a completely allergen-free environment due to the nature of external catering.

4. Photography and Media

- By attending a PAC event, you consent to being photographed or filmed for promotional, social media, and archival purposes.
- If you do not wish to be featured in event photography, please notify the event organisers or the photographer upon arrival.

5. Health and Safety

- Attendees must follow all safety instructions provided by event staff or venue management.
- PAC and the venue organisers accept no responsibility for any personal property that is lost, stolen, or damaged during an event.
- Participation in any event activities is at the attendee's own risk.

6. Data Protection
